

Getting to Alpha Tower:

From the West

Motorway connections: M5; M54

From M6

1. Leave the M6 at Junction 6 and follow signs for A38M Birmingham Central.
2. Stay on the A38M in the second lane for approximately 2 miles following signs for Birmingham City Centre
3. Pass over the flyover above Lancaster Circus (Aston University is on the left)
4. Proceed through St Chads Queensway tunnel. On leaving the tunnel, move into the left-hand lane and continue up to Paradise Circus island.
5. Take the first available exit from Paradise Circus, heading south down Suffolk Street Queensway.
6. Stay in the left-hand lane and take the first left into Brunel Street. At the bottom of Brunel Street turn right, passing under the Queensway elevated section, after which the road rounds to the left. The entrance to the car park for the Mailbox is on your right.
7. To walk to Alpha Tower from here, turn left out of the car park, up a short ramp that will bring you up next to Suffolk Street Queensway. Cross over Holliday Street and take the next access road to the front of Alpha Tower.
8. Alternative car parks are available at Brindley Drive, situated off Cambridge Street and the Brunel Street car park, off Suffolk Street Queensway.

Alternatively, from M5

1. Leave the M5 at Junction 3. At the motorway island follow signs for Birmingham City Centre (A456).
2. Keep on the A456 (Hagley Road West) for approximately 2 miles.
3. At the first set of traffic lights (the junction of the A4123) carry straight on following signs for Birmingham City Centre (A456).
4. Carry straight on over the second set of traffic lights, Hagley Road West becomes Hagley Road as you enter Edgbaston.
5. After a further 2.5 miles you will approach Five Ways island (do not take the tunnel under Five Ways). Take the third exit onto Islington Row Middleway (A4540)
6. Take the second left into Bath Row which leads into Holloway Head.
7. At the roundabout (Holloway Circus) turn left into Suffolk Street Queensway.
8. Take the second left and immediate right which takes you along the front of The Mailbox. At the next junction turn left which

takes you to the car park entrance.

9. To walk to Alpha Tower from here, turn left out of the car park, up a short ramp that will bring you up next to Suffolk Street Queensway. Cross over Holliday Street and take the next access road to the front of Alpha Tower.

10. Alternative car parks are available at Brindley Drive, situated off Cambridge Street and the Brunel Street car park, off Suffolk Street Queensway.
